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### Meeting of the Administrative Board – January 22, 2026

On **January 22, 2026** the **Administrative Board of Danubius International University** convened for an extraordinary meeting.

During the session, a series of decisions were unanimously approved by the attending members, concerning the university's academic and administrative activities.

We hereby publish the list of topics discussed and approved, while respecting institutional confidentiality:

- Proposal to update the composition of the Ethics Committee, in accordance with the provisions of Law 199/2023;
- Proposal to update the composition of the DIU's CEAC (Quality Assurance Committee);
- Endorsement of the requests submitted by graduates of other universities to take the bachelor's examination at Danubius International University;
- Approval of the proposal submitted by the Department for Teacher Training within the School of Smart Education and Innovative Educators, regarding the announcement of vacant teaching positions for competition in the second semester of the 2025–2026 academic year, for employment in the first semester of the 2026–2027 academic year;
- Approval of the enrollment capacity for the 2026–2027 school year within the Danubius International College of Applied and Vocational Studies, in accordance with Order of the Minister of Education and Research no. 6696/14.11.2025 approving the Methodology for establishing the enrollment capacity for public pre-university education and recording the number of children/pupils enrolled in private education units for the 2026–2027 school year;
- Setting the tuition fees for the 2026–2027 academic year;
- Presentation of the Report on the State of the University for the 2024–2025 academic year.

These decisions reflect the university's commitment to responsible, transparent governance, tailored to the needs of the academic community. In this regard, each adopted resolution contributes to the consolidation of a coherent institutional framework, where administrative and academic processes unfold in a harmonized and predictable manner. We aim for this approach to foster a climate of trust and collaboration, in which every member of the university community feels represented and actively contributes to the institution's development.
