The aim of Danubius University is to reach the convergence of research and didactic activities along with international openness, premises that can lead to a high level of quality needed by today's society.

Danubius University blends harmoniously and balanced the teaching and learning with the scientific research and it is involved in the global society projects through the services brought to the local, national and European community.

Danubius University values are confirmed by the appreciation and feed-back of the stakeholders. Our academic activity is guided by seriousness and consistency, nurturing the accomplishments of students, the continuous collaboration between eminent teachers and young assistants, integrity in all undertaken projects and non the less the potential to adapt rapidly and completely to changes.

Danubius University chooses its partners taking into consideration aspects such as: common goals, common interests, spatial proximity, partnership potential, the challenge of the partnership, the benefits of interculturality. Due to the dynamics of its development, Danubius University is interested in permanently development according to specific and complex demand of high quality services in the academic field locally, and also at the regional, national and international level. In order to ensure fair chances and access to mobility activities, priority will be given to first time participants in mobility and participation will be encouraged among students from disadvantaged social groups and students with disabilities.

Another core objective of Danubius University internationalization strategy is to further develop the mobility program and the cooperation under the Erasmus program by participating in intensive

programmes, academic networks and multilateral projects and developing our participation in Leonardo da Vinci, Grundvig projects and also in Erasmus Mundus and Tempus programs.

Danubius University promotes international programs in which is already partner as for example Lifelong Learning Programs - Erasmus and Leonardo da Vinci, also providing information and establishing contacts with different organizations and enterprises.

Danubius University offers support and advice to international students and staff before leaving home, upon arrival in Galati and during their stage in the area, helps to facilitate their accommodation, offers cultural and social counselling to the newcomers in Galati and Romania.
